Winter sick house syndrome = bad indoor air quality

Winter in Michigan is a roller coaster. Long stretches of very cold weather mean we close up our houses to keep the warm air in, and the cold air from blowing in around windows and doors. Many of us with older homes use the shrink-wrap window film to cover our windows on the inside to block the cold drafts.

This means we have less air circulation than during the rest of the year, when we can open windows to air out our homes. Less circulation means trouble if you burn paraffin candles in your home during the winter. The fumes from paraffin candles cause eye and sinus irritation, breathing problems, skin problems (especially on your face), and unhappy pets, children, guests and in-laws.

As people are becoming more sensitive to toxins in their environments, more and more people are switching to Beeswax candles, to reduce the toxins in the air they breath at home, work, church, and at their weddings, anniversaries, and reunions.
